Congregate donations are up. The SAC provides a free nutritious meal in a congregate setting four days a week to those 60 years old and older. Currently, we receive reimbursement at \$4/meal from Area V - Southeast Idaho Area Agency on Aging. This covers a fraction of our operating costs. City of Pocatello, City of Chubbuck, Bannock County, private business, civic organizations, and private individuals supplement funding. The donations we receive at mealtime are critical to bridge the gap in funding the full cost of the congregate meal program. The uptick in congregate donations not only keeps our program fully funded. The increase says we are doing something right. Thank you for your support!
